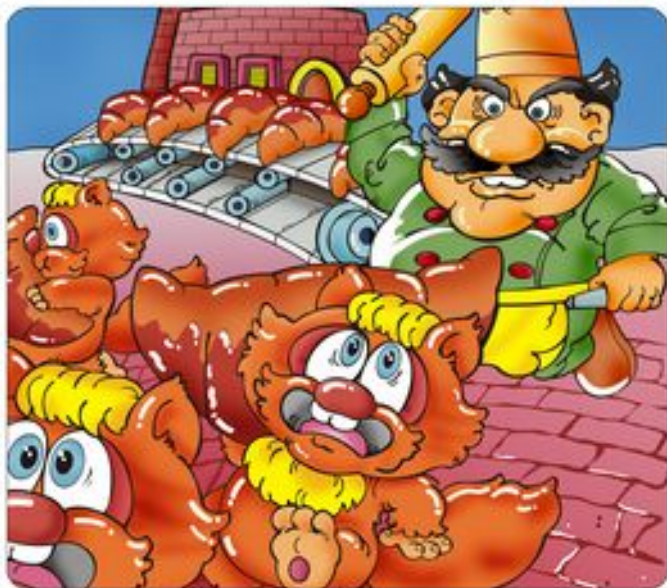

## GAME DESCRIPTION

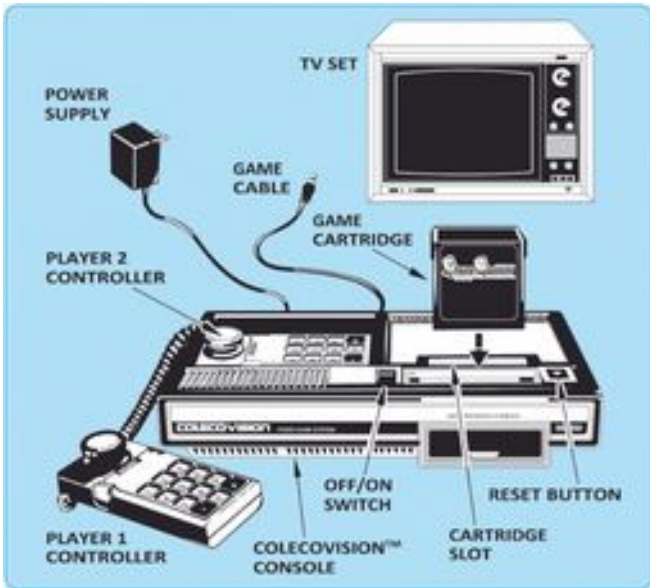

But what's this??!! A bunch of tricky RACCOON DOGS hanging around trying to sneak off with the bread!  
Can you get Joe the Baker to guard his bread from the rascally raccoon dogs?

## GETTING READY TO PLAY

---



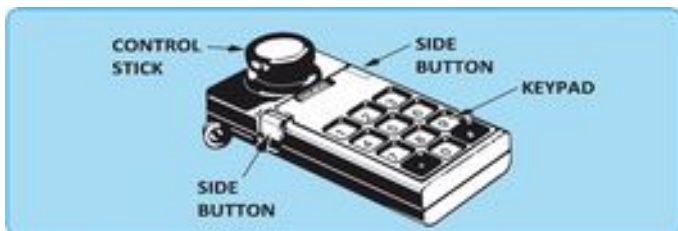
- Make sure the COLECOVISION™ console is connected to TV. Make sure power supply is plugged into console. Then plug power supply into a 110/120 volt AC outlet.

- TV should be on and tuned to same channel as the Channel Select switch on the console.
- To play Comic Bakery™, use the controller in Port 1 (the rear jack).
- **ALWAYS MAKE SURE COLECOVISION™ UNIT IS OFF BEFORE INSERTING OR REMOVING A CARTRIDGE.** Turn **Off/On** switch to **On** after cartridge is inserted.

## USING YOUR CONTROLLERS

---



Choose one or two player game. In two player game, each player plays alternately.

Use Control Stick to move Joe the baker left or right.

You can jump by pushing the Control Stick up.

Press any Side Button to use your hypnotizer beam in the direction you're heading. Beware, it takes time to reload.

Press # on keypad to pause the game.

Press \* when paused to reset the game.

# HERE'S HOW TO PLAY

People are waiting in the bakery shop for their bread and croissant to eat. Joe must hurry to satisfy his customers. Everything would be ok without the raccoons trying to steal his production in his automated bakery. Joe desperately needs your help !



All along the making process, bread has to get through different machines. The first one produces bread dough, then bread is molded, raised and finally baked.

A conveyor belt allows the breads to go through each machine before ending into the truck which will bring them hot to the bakery shop.

Beware, everything must be ready for 5:00pm.

You have to keep each machine on while raccoons try to turn them off and steal the breads.

To turn a machine on, simply face the switch lever.

If a raccoon bites you, you lose a life.

You can jump over raccoons or use your hypnotizer device to stun them for a while. The beam will be shot in the direction you're heading when pressing a Side Button.

Stunned raccoons on the floor can be eliminated by walking into them.

You've got a map of the bakery factory on top of the screen which helps you to see which machine is stopped.



Time is up when it's 5:00pm and your production is brought to the waiting customers. If there is not enough bread for everybody, you lose a life.

**NOTE:** The Reset Button on the console “clears” the computer. It can be used to start a new game at any time, and can also be used in the event of game malfunction.

## SCORING

---

Switch a machine on	50 points
Eliminate a raccoon	120 points
Stun a raccoon on floor	200 points
Stun a raccoon on wall	300 points
Deliver a bread	600 points
