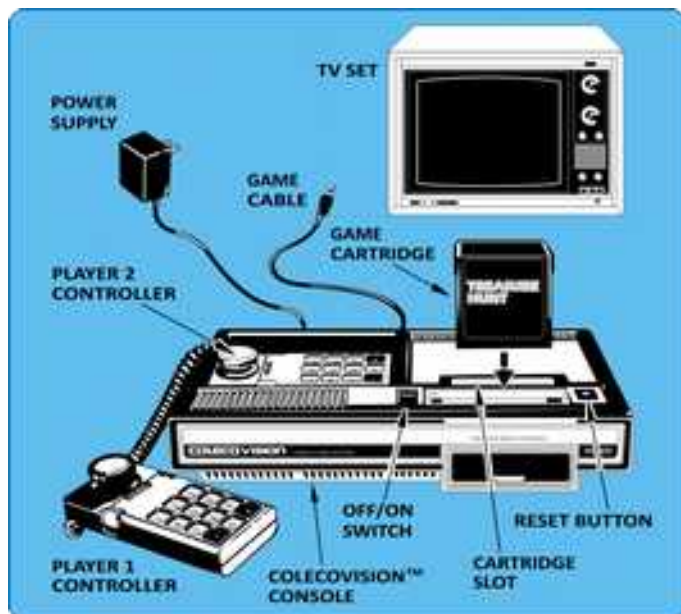

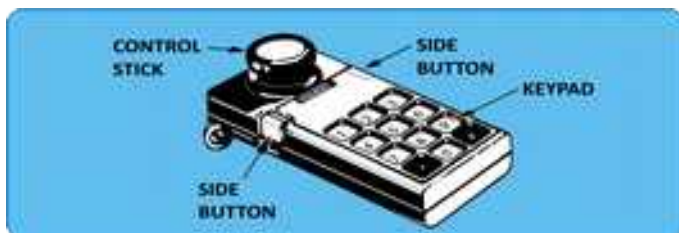
GETTING READY TO PLAY



- Make sure the COLECOVISION™ or compatible console is connected to TV. Make sure power supply is plugged into console. Then plug power supply into a 110/120 volt AC outlet.
- TV should be on and tuned accordingly to your console manual.
- **ALWAYS MAKE SURE COLECOVISION™ OR COMPATIBLE UNIT IS OFF BEFORE INSERTING OR REMOVING A CARTRIDGE.**

Turn **Off/On** switch to **On** after cartridge is inserted.

USING YOUR CONTROLLERS



Pushing the Control Stick up, down, left or right causes Bob to swim in the same direction.

Press Left Side Button to switch scrolling direction.

Press Right Side Button to shoot.

HERE'S HOW TO PLAY

NOTE: If you are playing a two-player game, players take turns. Player 1 begins, and each turn lasts until the player's next diver dies.

Wait for the Game Option screen to appear. Select 1-4 option for a one player game. Select 5-8 option for a two player game. Game Options 1 and 5 are easy versions, especially designed for beginners. When you get better, try one of the harder games (2, 3, 4, 6, 7 or 8).



Avoid deadly sea creatures or kill them with your harpoon. You can find ammunition when you have no arrow left.

Take the key to open the gate to reach the next level.

You will also find oxygen tanks to resupply before you die.

The game ends when all your divers have died. To replay the same Game Option that you have been playing, press *. Or you can go back to the Game Option screen by pressing #.

TRIVIA



Hanimex (Jack Hannes Import and Export) was an Australian trading company that imported cameras, Pong-like games and game consoles. At the beginning of the 80s, they chose to distribute a family computer, the **Pencil II**, produced by a Hong Kong-

based company called **Soundic Electronics**. It seems that this computer was sold in Australia and in France.

The Pencil II also came with an interesting expansion cartridge. The regular cartridge port was the exact same size as a ColecoVision cartridge, and when you plugged the "ColecoVision Support" cartridge into the side of the unit, it played regular ColecoVision games.

Three cartridges are known to exist for the Pencil II. One is the SD-Basic language provided with the machine and the other two are games: PEN701-Le Jardin Magique (Magic Garden) and PEN702-Treasure Hunt (*Le Plongeur A La Recherche du Trésor* in French). A third game might exist: Big Foot Chase.
