

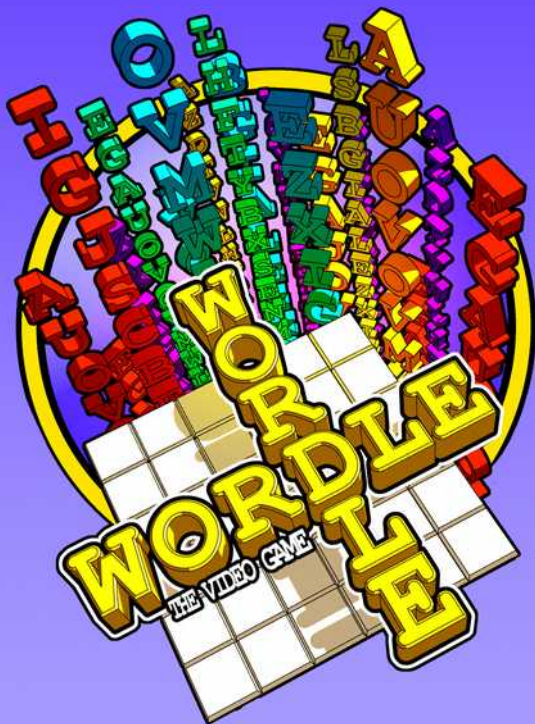

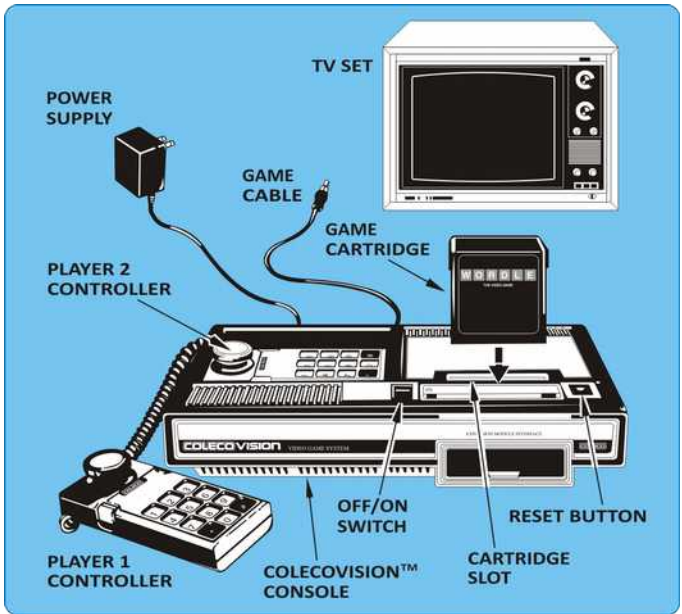

### GAME DESCRIPTION

---

Your challenge is to guess a five-letter word in six attempts. Each time you guess, you're told which of your chosen letters are in the target word, and whether they are in the right place.

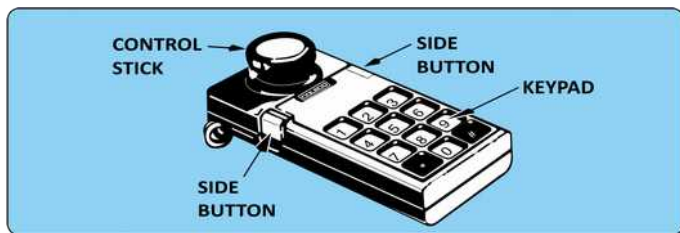
# GETTING READY TO PLAY



- Make sure the COLECOVISION™ or compatible console is connected to TV. Make sure power supply is plugged into console. Then plug power supply into a 110/120 volt AC outlet.
- TV should be on and tuned accordingly to your console manual.
- **ALWAYS MAKE SURE COLECOVISION™ OR COMPATIBLE UNIT IS OFF BEFORE INSERTING OR REMOVING A CARTRIDGE.**

Turn **Off/On** switch to **On** after cartridge is inserted.

## USING YOUR CONTROLLERS



Pressing any of the Side Buttons on Controller 1 on the start screen will start the game.

At any moment pressing 0 will stop the background music. Pressing 9 will start it.

Inside the game use the Control Stick to move around the on-screen keyboard.

Pressing any of the Side Buttons will select a letter.

When selecting the DEL key on the on-screen keyboard one letter will be deleted.

When 5 letters have been selected followed by selecting the ENT key on the on-screen keyboard, the word entered will be checked.

When less than 5 letters have been selected, the ENT key on the on-screen keyboard will do nothing.

# HERE'S HOW TO PLAY

Wordle is such a simple game that there are hardly any rules. But here you go:

- You have to guess the Wordle in six goes or less.
- Every word you enter must be in the game's list of 3600 words.
- A correct letter turns green.
- A correct letter in the wrong place turns yellow.
- An incorrect letter turns gray.
- Letters can be used more than once.
- Answers are never plurals.



## 1 Enter a 5-letter word

You'll have 6 chances to guess the 5-letter word, so make every guess count! Try using a word that contains many different letters to narrow down your future guesses. Type your first guess by moving the green cursor on the letters of your choice and press Side Button. When your word is complete, select ENT to see if you've matched any letters.

## 2 Check the letter colors

After you make a guess, the letter colors will change:

Green indicates that you've guessed the correct letter in the correct place in the word. Yellow means you've guessed a letter that's in the word, but not in the right spot. Gray means that letter is not in the word. The color of the tiles of the virtual keyboard reflects the result. If a word cannot be found in the game's dictio-

nary, the word will be shown in red and the guess is marked as wrong but can be retried.



### 3 Guess another word

Use the clues you got from your first guess to try again. Remember, don't reuse any of the gray letters, as they are definitely not in the word.

If you correctly guessed a letter at the correct position (a green letter), make sure to use that letter at that position in your second guess. Letters can appear more than once in the same word.

### 4 Go on

Continue entering your guesses until all letters are green. When you've correctly guessed the word, you'll hear a sound.

## SCORING

---

- At each guess, a correct letter and at correct position 10 points.
- At each guess, a correct letter but at the wrong position 5 points.
- Guessing word in 1 go 1000 points.
- Guessing word in 2 go's 500 points.
- Guessing word in 3 go's 333 points.
- Guessing word in 4 go's 250 points.
- Guessing word in 5 go's 200 points.
- Guessing word in 6 go's 166 points.

This instruction booklet will provide the basic information you need to get started playing Wordle™, but it is only the beginning! You will find that this cartridge is full of special features that make Wordle™ exciting every time you play. Experiment with different techniques and enjoy the game!
